The North Carolina Watermelon Festival would like to invite you to participate in the Festival Market for 2022.

General Information

Festival Market Vendor Dates: August 5-August 6, 2022

Location: 200 East Broad St, Corner of Sycamore and Broad Streets, Murfreesboro, NC

Fee: \$60.00 for one 15ft. X 15ft. space. No exceptions on the size. An additional 15ft X 15ft is

available for \$60.00.

Vendor Hours: Friday August 5, 12PM-sunset. Set-up, 9AM-11AM. Saturday, August 6, 10AM-5PM. Set-up 8AM-9AM.

- 1. Vendor fees must accompany all mail in applications and are deposited upon receipt. Depositing of your check does not mean acceptance of the festival as a vendor. In the event of a denial of an application, a full refund will be made. Online applications will receive an invoice upon acceptance and payable thru PayPal.
- 2. A confirmation letter and map will be sent to you prior to the festival.
- 3. All vendors must occupy the space provided and specified by the festival committee.
- 4. Vendors must provide their own tables, chairs, tents and generators (if needed).
- 5. There are limited spaces available for those requiring generators due to fire code restrictions
- 6. No electrical outlets are available.
- 7. No parking is allowed on the festival site except for loading and unloading.
- 8. Vendors assume responsibility for any items on the festival site after hours on Friday August 5.
- 9. Friday, August 5, set-up time will be from 9AM-11AM. The festival opens at noon and all vehicles must be removed by that time. Saturday, August 6, set-up will be from 8AM-9AM. The parade starts at 10.
- 10. The Market will close at 5PM on Saturday. Pack up and check out begins strictly at 5PM and vendors must be out by 6.
- 11. The NC Watermelon Festival in Murfreesboro is not liable or responsible for delays, cancellations or postponement of the festival or events within the festival due to inclement weather, war, government actions, strike, or other matters beyond our control.
